- We co-create a curriculum to include STEM subjects with the students which will all be taught through less conventional methods emphasising process over product and embracing students ingenuity. Learning settings will be formed of part academic workshops, part interest and project-based learning and part self-directed learning, all being underpined by nurturing and evolving the
 - many skills needed for future employment.

Platforms we use to support and record the Progress each individual makes.

Each child will be allocated a key worker to support their journey. They will have a Boxall profile at in the first term with us and this will be updated at the end of each term. We will also use Tapestry as a communication and monitoring tool between us, home and school. This is a 3-way communication support. The individual's key worker will upload a roundup of the week and celebrate all of the successes that they have had. We will record and document any behaviour, incidents or accidents both in and out of the provision. We are happy to visit the child at their school to support transition back to full time school. All learning will be planned and delivered to the child's need and ability with 3 overarching big term projects.
