Emotional Support

- We are happy to offer hugs and cuddles to children who seek or need comfort, provided both the child and their parent/guardian are comfortable with this.
- Our aim is to provide reassurance and build a trusting bond with the children in our care.

Safety and Supervision

- For safety reasons, we will hold hands with children during outings or when walking near roads.
- In situations where safety is at risk, such as separating children during a fight or preventing a child from running into the road, we may need to restrain them gently and appropriately.

Personal Care

- We provide necessary assistance for personal hygiene, including washing hands, wiping noses, and helping children use the toilet, in line with their age and developmental stage.
- If a child has an accident, we will assist in changing their clothes to ensure they remain comfortable.

Parental Communication and Consent

- Physical interactions such as cuddles or holding hands are guided by the child's needs and preferences, ensuring their comfort and trust.

- We encourage open communication with parents to ensure they feel confident in the level of care and support we provide.
