Every child's journey is unique, and we are here to support them in finding their path to success.

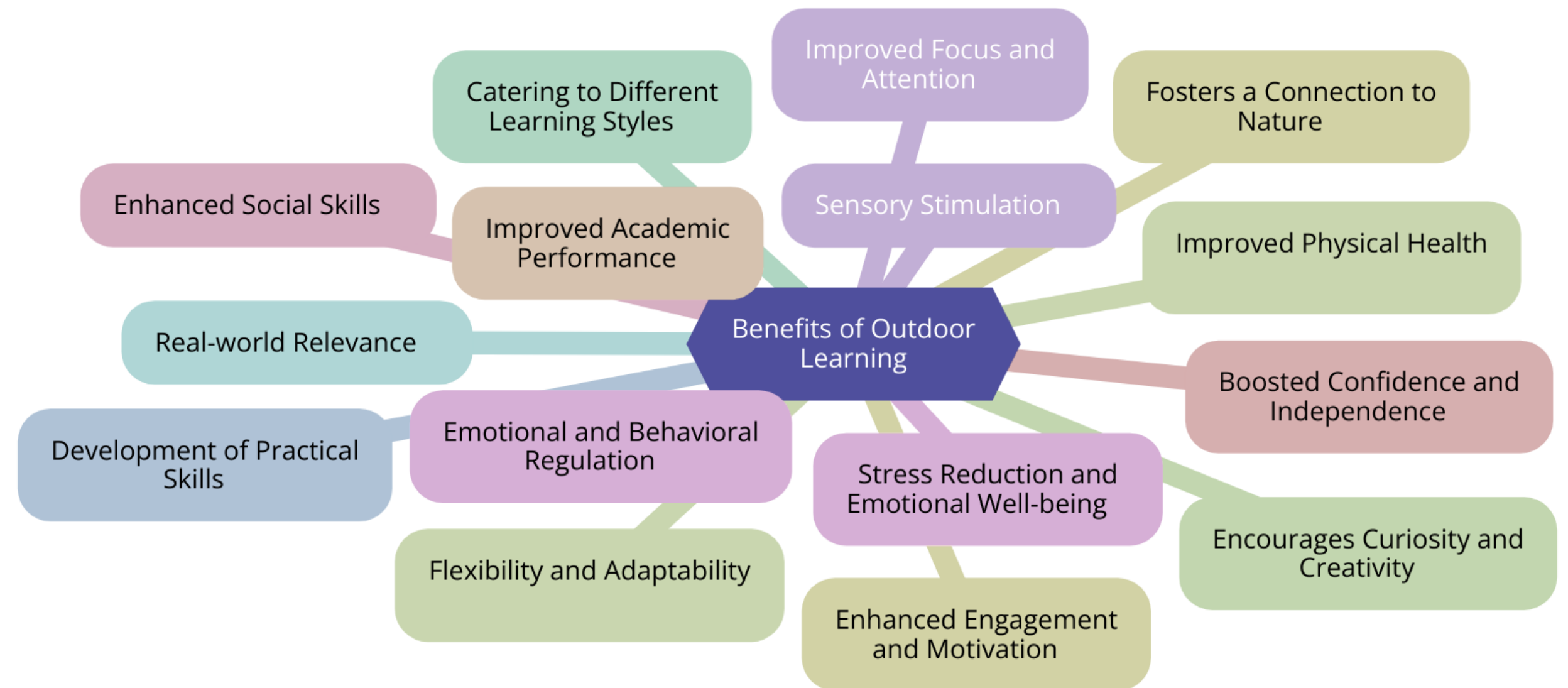

Establishing our Alternative Provision at Thames Valley Adventure Playground has proven to be highly advantageous due to the unique and inclusive environment it offers. This specialist setting is specifically designed to accommodate children and adults with various needs and disabilities, providing a safe and supportive space for a wide range of learning and recreational activities. By situating our program in this exceptional facility, we have significantly enhanced the educational experience, promoting physical, social, and emotional development. We have committed to building individualised learning programs that support each child and their specific needs. The integration with Thames Valley Adventure Playground has fostered a strong sense of community and belonging, ensuring that our students benefit from tailored activities and personalized learning experiences that traditional settings may not be able to provide.



Platforms we use to support and record the Progress each individual makes.

- Each child will be allocated a key worker to support their journey. They will have a Boxall profile at in the first term with us and this will be updated at the end of each term. We will also use Tapestry as a communication and monitoring tool between us, home and school. This is a 3-way communication support. The individual's key worker will upload a roundup of the week and celebrate all of the successes that they have had. We will record and document any behaviour, incidents or accidents both in and out of the provision. We are happy to visit the child at their school to support transition back to full time school. All learning will be planned and delivered to the child's need and ability with 3 overarching big term projects.
