We will value all children equally and treat them with equal concern and without discrimination.

We will endeavour to:

- Recognise and respect all types of different racial origins, religions, cultures, and languages, each child is valued as an individual without racial or gender stereotyping. We will also not discriminate against children on the grounds of disability, sexual orientation, age, class, or family status.
- Provide and make sure that all children have access to a range of books, puzzles and other toys which provide positive images and examples of the diversity of life in our society.
- Encourage children to treat each other with respect - discriminatory remarks will not be tolerated. Such remarks will be dealt with immediately with sensitivity shown both to the child making the remark as well as the child it was intended for.
- Provide equal chances for each child to learn and develop their full potential, considering each child's age and stage of development, gender, ethnicity, home language and ability.
- Provide medical, cultural, and dietary needs wherever possible.
- Be inclusive of children with Special Educational Needs and differentiated disabilities.
